Furthermore, photography is Lorraine M. Nesensohn's livelihood, how she supports her family. One or two people scanning may not have an effect on her business, but imagine if it were more than one or two people. That would have an impact on her business, as well as her family.

"But don't I own images of my own child?"

When a photographer takes images of you or your child, the images are copyrighted. You have the permission to hang the images up in your home and enjoy them; you do not have permission to make copies of the images. This includes home printers or printers at local camera shops and convenience stores (such as Duane Reade, CVS, Wal-Mart, etc). We keep in close contact with local stores, letting them know that we are to be alerted when issues of copyright come up in their stores.

She goes to great lengths to provide you with top-quality, beautiful images that you are proud to display and share. Copying and scanning these images greatly reduces their beauty and quality.
